### Child Sponsorship

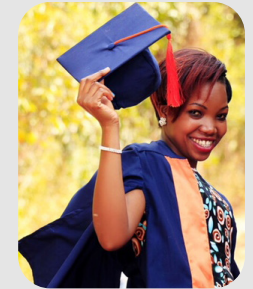
### General Support



Our general fund is used to purchase a Bible for each of our new children, pay rent for those in crisis, cover medical expenses, and take care of other unexpected needs.

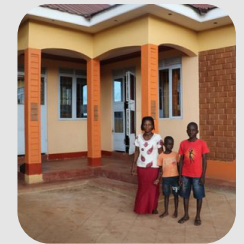
### Higher Education
